Haley served as White House political appointee in the Administration of President Barack Obama, as chief of staff to the President's Auto Task Force at the U.S Department of the Treasury and to the President's Senior Counselor for Manufacturing Policy. Stevens was appointed as Special Advisor to the U.S Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration, where she oversaw mayors' and governors' outreach and manufacturing initiatives.

Haley holds a Masters in Philosophy and Social Policy and Bachelors in Political Science and Philosophy, both from American University. She attended Oxford University as a visiting student during her junior year of study.
