



Mr. John U. Carney is the Director of the Navy ManTech Program in the Sea Warfare & Weapons Department at the Office of Naval Research.

He has been the Director of the Navy ManTech Program since 2005 and is responsible for budgeting and executing the Program. He interprets DoD ManTech guidance and sets Navy policy for program budgeting, contracting, execution, and management. He is responsible for implementing the ManTech Program investment strategy and works with targeted acquisition programs to develop focused initiatives



to provide in-depth manufacturing technology development for these platforms. As Director, Mr. Carney provides technical direction and administrative oversight for all personnel in the Manufacturing Technology Division. Since becoming Navy ManTech Director, Mr. Carney has focused on two main goals: (1) executing an investment strategy that supports acquisition cost reduction for the highest priority platforms and (2) improving program planning and execution, to most effectively utilize the resources of the program.

Mr. Carney has been with the Navy for over 25 years working at the Naval Surface Warfare Center, Carderock Division; on detail to the Naval Sea Systems Command; and since 1998 at the Office of Naval Research. He has a Bachelor of Science degree in Industrial Engineering and Operations Research and a Master of Engineering Administration degree, both from Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University.
